

Heartland Dental Care raises additional funds for Hurricane Katrina victims

Heartland Dental Care recently raised more than \$4,000 for the American Red Cross Hurricane Katrina Relief Fund to benefit its disaster victims. Funds were generated from whitening sales held in participating Heartland offices during the month of September. A portion of the sales was earmarked for hurricane relief.
